## Prior to Instruction

Program student's AAC devices with target vocabulary words and vocabulary. For students needing additional visual support, provide your students with ***The Three Little Pigs*** Visual Support Cards. Sample words and phrases include:

- Title
- Author
- Illustrator
- Built Houses
- Were Safe
- Met the Wolf

## Introduce the Task

We are going to write about the story, *The Three Little Pigs*. The author of our story, James Halliwell-Phillips, chose the title, *The Three Little Pigs*. Titles tell us important information about what we will read about. We know from the title, *The Three Little Pigs*, that the story is going to be about three little pigs. Today we are going to help the author of the story, James Halliwell-Phillips, think of different titles for this story. The new titles we come up with need to make sense and tell the readers what they are going to be reading about.



## Learning Objectives

- Students will write an alternate title for the text and select illustrations that support their title.
- Students will capitalize the first word in a sentence.
- Students will use drawings or visual displays to add detail to written products or discussions.
- Students will recall information from literature or experiences to answer questions.
