Core Vocabulary and Definitions

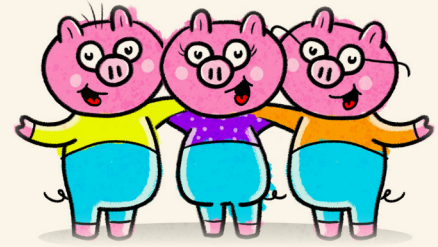
The “big idea” concept word has an asterisk:

- Materials
- Color
- Texture
- Property*

Prior to Instruction

Program student AAC devices with target vocabulary words (materials, color, texture, property) and image or pictures (with the definition programmed). Sample words and definitions include:

- “Materials”: “The substance something is made from.”
- “Color”: “What you see when light is reflected, or bounced off of objects.”
- “Texture”: “The feel of a surface or material.”
- “Property”: “A characteristic or quality of something.”
- Program image of a green check to voice “property” and red X to voice “not property.”



Learning Objectives

- Students will identify core vocabulary.
- Students will identify examples and non-examples of the big idea.
- Students will identify that objects are different colors and textures.
- Students will identify that a property is a characteristic of an object.
- Students will identify that color and texture are properties of objects.
