

# Core Vocabulary with Constant Time Delay

## Core Vocabulary and Definitions

The “big idea” concept word has an asterisk:

- Problem\*
- Solution
- Disagree

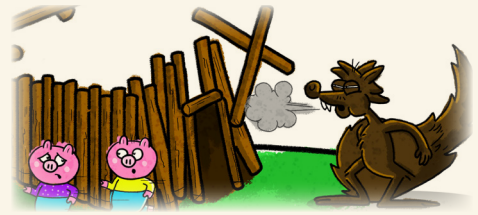
## Prior to Instruction

Program student AAC devices with target vocabulary words (problem, solution, disagree) and image or pictures (with the definition programmed). Sample words and definitions include:

- “Problem”: “Something that needs to be fixed.”
- “Solution”: “A way to fix something.”
- “Disagree”: “When people do not have the same ideas.”
- Program image of a green check to voice “problem” and red X to voice “not problem.”

## Anchor Instruction for All Students

**There was a problem in the story, *The Three Little Pigs*. The wolf blew down the little pigs’ houses. Their problem was they did not have a house anymore! The two little pigs needed a solution. They solved their problem by going to live with the third little pig.**



## Learning Objectives

- Students will identify core vocabulary.
- Students will identify examples and non-examples of the big idea.
- Students will answer questions about the properties of objects.
